Public Meetings Scheduled for Input on
Trinity Corridor Land Use Plan

Dallas residents are encouraged to attend one of more than a dozen meetings that have been scheduled regarding a land use plan for the Trinity River Corridor. The stakeholder meetings will be held Feb. 23 through March 7. On March 9, a Community Workshop will be held at the Yvonne A. Ewell Townview Center, 1201 East 8th Street.

Hired by the City of Dallas, HNTB Corporation and associated subconsultants have been conducting a study of both sides of the Trinity River. During this series of meetings, stakeholders will provide input into long-range visions for the Trinity River Corridor and options for development along the Trinity Parkway alignments.

“Public input has always been an important part of the study and the Trinity River Corridor Project,” said Rebecca Dugger, Director of the Trinity River Corridor Project. “We are anxious to update the citizens on the work that has been done so far. This important effort will help us determine what the corridor and the communities near the river should look like in 50 to 60 years.”

This is the third series of stakeholder meetings and community workshops that have been hosted by the Trinity River Corridor Project.

The first of the stakeholder meetings will be a joint meeting with the Elm Fork Floodplain Management Plan. This special meeting will allow residents and business owners in the Luna Road - Walnut Hill area the opportunity to learn more about floodplain management proposals for the area and how they interact with land use issues. The meeting will be held at the Bachman Recreation Center, 2750 Bachman Drive, on February 23 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.
